She is also an expert in English language and other language like Hindi, Gujarati, Punjabi, etc.

She began her talk with introducing foreign language, what is their importance and how it can help in improving our communications with other countries. She told us about the lifestyle of the foreign people. She added to it how a person is treated in Germany if he/she is good at their language, she shared her experience regarding the same, how she was treated and felt about knowing their language. The syllables of German language are quite similar to that of Sanskrit. Also most of the ancient scripts are now recovered by Germans, which were lost during wars.

Apart from knowing the language, she also included how they lived, following all the rules and were disciplined, also that even small kid followed all the rules citing an example of road crossing.

She also made us aware about some important companies which belonged to Germany like Volkswagen, Allianz, Daimler, etc.

She included the point of using one's language is very important, like the German, Chinese, Russian, etc. who always used their own language for international trades and commerce.

One of the most important drawback of Indian as cited by her was how easily the people are influenced by western culture and customs, and easily we adopt theirs's, forgetting our culture. This has kept us from becoming a developed country for so long.
